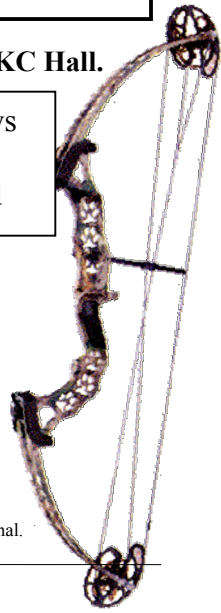

RULES

- Contest includes Archery Only and General season (Youth-Only dates also allowed for youth hunters) as outlined by Texas Parks & Wildlife. Use of **Crossbows** are **not allowed**. Entry form with \$15 fee must be postmarked or dropped off at one of the Drop Off locations by Friday Oct. 2, 2009 at the close of business. Make checks payable to BigBuck BowHunt.
- The BigBuck BowHunt will have 4 divisions:
Lavaca County Adult Division- buck harvested in Lavaca County with a bow by a hunter 17 or older as of Oct. 3, 2009.
Lavaca County Youth Division – buck harvested in Lavaca County with a bow by a hunter 16 or younger as of Oct. 3, 2009.
Texas Open Division – buck harvested by an adult or youth hunter in Texas other than Lavaca County or the Special South Texas Counties.
South Texas Division – buck harvested by an adult or youth hunter in an area described as the Special South Texas in the Texas Parks & Wildlife.
- The \$15 fee enters a hunter in all divisions applicable by age as outlined in Rule #2; however the hunter can claim only one prize in the contest overall.
- Deer must be a legal Whitetail buck harvested during legal seasons as defined by Texas Parks & Wildlife. The hunter must follow county game laws for the county in which they are hunting.
- A Lavaca County buck must be measured within 24 hours of harvest by one of the Official Scoring judges listed below.
- A buck with cape and antlers attached must be presented for scoring.
- South Texas & Texas Open Division bucks must be measured within 72 hours of harvest by one of the Official Scoring judges listed below.
- A buck with cape and antlers attached must be presented for scoring.
- Winners will be decided by the total gross score using the Pope & Young method of scoring. Tie breakers will be determined by the longest single point off of either main beam. All measurements are rounded to the nearest 1/8". In the event that placing entries are within 1 point of each other, 3 official judges will re-score the bucks. The final score will be an average of the 4 scorers' results.
- The buck must be legally harvested and properly tagged according to the most recent Texas Parks & Wildlife Outdoor Annual.
- Deer cannot be harvested in a deer proof fenced in area or cannot have been raised in a fenced-in area and released.
- Random lie detector tests may be administered if deemed necessary by the contest committee. Any contestant that fails to comply with such request will be disqualified from current and future contests.
- Any hunter trying to cheat in this contest will be automatically disqualified, forfeit their prize and will be banned from entering again.
- By entering the contest, you have agreed to comply with the rules and the decisions made by the committee members. All decisions of the committee will be final.
